1. SPORTING REGULATIONS - GENERAL

1.1 Title & Jurisdiction:

The Bugatti Owners' Club 'New Barn Land Rover Specialist' RS Interclub Licence Championship is organised and administered by the Bugatti Owners' Club in accordance with the General Regulations of the Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Championship Regulations or, be a professional driver in possession of a valid Licence (featuring an E.U. flag) and medical, issued by the ASN of a member country of the European Union.

Status: Interclub as a minimum

1.3 Competitor Eligibility:

1.3.1 Drivers and Entrant/Drivers must be fully paid up, valid member of the Bugatti Owners' Club Ltd., be registered for the Championship and be in possession of a valid RS Interclub Competition Licence.

1.3.2 Competitors shall not take time off school to participate in motor sport without the prior written approval of their school. If participation in the Championship requires absence from school, Drivers in full time school education are required to have the approval of their head teacher and a letter stating such approval from his/her school in order to fulfil registration for the Championship.

1.3.3 All necessary documentation must be available for checking at all rounds when signing-on.

1.3.4 All necessary documentation must be presented for checking at all rounds when signing-on.

1.3.5 Due to demand from competitors, we have taken the decision to split the championship into two classes based on hill climbing experience. If you have been competing in hill climbing for two years or more, you will need to state this on your registration form and will be a part of the 'Expert' sub-section, and if you are new to the sport (under two years of competing) you will be a part of the 'Novice' sub-section.

1.4 Registration:

- 1.4.1 Registration forms are available from and should be returned to; Bugatti Owners' Club, Prescott Hill, Gotherington, Cheltenham, GL52 9RD. Telephone 01242 673136 during office hours. Entry Forms may be downloaded from the 'www.prescotthillclimb.co.uk' website.
- 1.4.2 The registration fee for the Championship is £32.00.
- 1.4.3 Competitors must register at least seven days before the first event in which they intend to compete. Entry into the Championship commences from the date of registration and points will not be awarded retrospectively.
- 1.4.4 Whilst every effort will be made to circulate event supplementary regulations, the onus is on the entrant to obtain them.
- 1.4.5 Drivers must compete in a minimum of six dedicated rounds to qualify for an end of season award.
- 1.4.6 To be eligible for marking in the series all competing cars must carry Championship decals as laid down in the advertising rules issued by Motorsport UK under H28.1.2 and H28.1.3.

1.5 Championship Rounds:

1.5 The following events form the Qualifying Rounds of the 2022 Championship:

1.6 Scoring:

1.6.1 The Championship will be based on handicap scoring and points scored are based on results from the events entered purely on the order of finish of cars. Points will be awarded as follows, split into two classes, sports cars and saloon cars with two points for starting the event plus one point for practicing, then the following applies;

5 starters or more competing:

1st = 30 points

2nd = 25 points

3rd = 22 points

4th = 20 points

5th = 18 points

6th = 16 points

7th = 14 points

8th = 12 points

9th = 10 points

10th = 9 points

11th = 8 points

12th = 7 points

13th = 6 points

14th = 5 points

the rest = 4 points(based on one practice run)

There are nine dedicated rounds. From these rounds the entrants best six results count towards the end of season final scoring.

1.6.2 In the event of a tie the overall winner will be decided on the most first places, then the most second places etc. the overall winner will not be eligible for any other award.

1.6.3 Any appeals against points must be lodged in accordance with the Motorsport UK Year Book procedure.

1.6.4 Anybody beating their handicap by more than 5% will score a maximum of 4 points.

1.6.5 Points will be published regularly on the championship website.

1.7 Awards:

1.7.1 The season will conclude with the 'New Barn Land Rover' Championship Trophy going to the overall winner with the most points scored in the final Championship standings.

1.7.2 The season will also conclude with a 'Novice of the Year' award which will be the novice scoring the most points in the overall championship standings. In order to be eligible for the award, you must declare on your championship registration form that you are a novice (have been hill climbing competitively for less than two years).

1.7.3 The Peter Stubberfield Trophy will be awarded for the best performance other than the champion in a Sports Car, with an award for second and third place.

1.7.4 The Jack Perkins Plate will be awarded for the best performance other than the champion in a Saloon Car, with an award for second and third place.

2. SPORTING REGULATIONS - JUDICIAL PROCEDURES

3. SPECIFIC CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS

3.1 By registering for the Championship all competitors and their associates commit to positively promote and demonstrate the Motorsport UK's Respect Code which is appended to these regulations (Appendix 1).

3.1.1. Where any reports of disrespectful conduct are judged to be well founded the Championship organisers may issue warnings or require remedial actions and/or report the matter to the Championship Stewards who may impose appropriate penalties which can include loss of Championship points and/or race bans through to Championship Expulsion and referral to Motorsport UK.

3.1.2. It is imperative that we promote the safety and wellbeing of young people and adults at risk. In addition to this all participants must be aware of their behaviour and conduct at all times and abusive language and harmful behaviour will not be tolerated. Any such incidents must be reported to the Championship Coordinator and/or Safeguarding Officer who will also relay the report Motorsport UK. 4. **TECHNICAL REGULATIONS**

4.1 The Bugatti Owners' Club 'New Barn Land Rover' Speed Championship is open to competitors participating in any road registered and road legal car, to be eligible for the Championship all vehicles must comply with the Common Regulations and Specific Regulations for Road Cars - Series Production (S12.1.1) and Road-Cars - Specialist Production (S12.1.2) cars in the 2022 Motorsport UK Year Book Section S12, Specific Regulations for Sprints, Hill Climbs and Drag Racing.

Competitors are reminded that vehicles should be fitted with original interior trim ie: doorcards & headlinings.

Interior equipment ie: heaters, sunroof, window mechanisms, door handles etc must be retained & be working.

The organisers reserve the right to decline entries for vehicles considered not in the spirit of the championship.

Note: Competitors are reminded they may need to supply proof of current Insurance Certificates, MOT and vehicle tax. Certificates (if applicable) may be inspected at any round.

5. **ENVIRONMENTAL CONCERNS**

Motorsport UK are exceedingly concerned of the impact of single-use plastic tyre wrapping and with reusable alternatives available competitors are encouraged to reduce plastic usage in this regard. Use of these plastic wraps is to be eradicated by 2023.
